### The Do-Dah Parade

June 6, 2015

Step-off at 11 a.m. Gates open at 9 a.m.





#### Overview:

The "Do-Dah Parade" is Saturday, June 6, 2015 at 11 am. The parade will travel the traditional Do-Dah parade route (Lovell, Park, Michigan, Portage, back to Lovell), starting at the corner of Jasper and Lovell Street.

Do-Dah Parade started in 1984, when WKMI organizers designed the parade as a way for companies and organizations to provide unique entertainment through a parody. It was patterned after the Pasadena, California Parade called Doo Dah. The purpose remains the same – create the un-structured, un-proper, and totally goofy parade. Maybe a better word would be a zooy outrageous costume parade. Each year, participants are challenged to reinvigorate the meaning of "Do-Dah" (a parody based on a spoof or a satire of a person, place, event or thing). Being creative can be a challenge, but when you do – it will make your group be remembered. Our goal is for this year's parade to be the funniest yet!

Enclosed is the application; please complete and send back by May 15th. The parade is limited to 70 units, so get your "groove" on, complete the application, and send it back. Here are some highlights:

- 1. This weekend is called the June Jubilee weekend (combining our traditional and most favorite events we called "Super Saturday" for so long). We encourage artistic celebration with a parody. Creativity is an art. We might even have a Queen of Do-Dah be our Parade Marshal. Watch for try-outs in case you know a person who could be queen.
- 2. Do-Dah Parade will only be successful if there is a whole lot of parodies, silliness, raucous costuming, and art. To insure this happens, we are <u>limiting each unit to 10%</u> promotion of your organization. Please note, we have the parade constabularies who will check your units before you hit the streets.
- 3. The parade application fee was increased to \$50. This is to help cover our expenses and ensure Do-Dah is an event for years to come. If you would like to have your company be a sponsor and gain advertising exposure we would love to send you a proposal.
- 4. Please make sure to complete **all** portions of the application including the waiver statement. Confirmations will be sent via email and the final packet will be mailed the week of May 15. If you do not receive email confirmation within a week of sending in your application, please call us (269-388-2830). The final line-up information will also be posted on the KELC website.

There are two ways to participate in Do-Dah: a) unit based on a spoof or a satire of a person, place, event or thing; or b) dress your unit up in outrageous costumes. We also encourage the use of art carts and music. Descriptions will be used to promote your participation prior to the parade and create media human interest stories. This is a family event and your unit is a reflection of your organization and participants – we trust it will be done in good taste.

- Entries are arranged in the parade based on their entertainment value. Applications received after the deadline will be added at the end.
- ONLY 10% OF THE UNIT CAN BE ADVERTISING FOR YOUR ORGANIZATION/BUSINESS. So, that means that commercial vehicles that are not COMPLETELY part of the decorated unit are not permitted.
- ❖ ALL PARTICIPANTS MUST BE IN COSTUME! Costumes and/or attire of all participants must reflect overall parody theme of the entry. This is where the parade constabularies will be taking note − they will have badges, clipboards, and if you don't follow the guidelines, we might put you at the back of the parade with a banner that says − the UN-DO-DAH Parade units.
- Vehicles and floats must be of good working order and state licensed-approved.
- We reserve the right to not accept a unit if it is offensive, inappropriate, or poorly reflects the integrity of the parade.
- Approach Parade officials reserve the right to ensure the safety of participants and viewers and to that regard, officials have the authority to remove a unit from the parade if it poses a threat to the safety or security of others.
- ❖ Incomplete applications will not be considered for final entry acceptance.



## Do-Dah Parade Examples of a Parody



**Parody:** an attempt or imitation that is so poor that it seems ridiculous – but in good taste. Amusing - Imitation - a piece of writing or music that deliberately copies another work in a comic or satirical way. Think "Saturday Night Live" as an example of parodies.



In 2010, there was a rescue of our auto industry. Although the results proved positive for our auto industry, at the time it was a good parody to feature.





Kalamazoo and Portage Rotary Clubs honored Thell as his biker angels. Scooters were the "bikes" and rotary members wore the "leathers." It was a spoof from all sides of the equation.

#### **Do-Dah Parade**

#### **General Parade Information and Guidelines**



The Purpose: The Do-Dah Parade has been in existence since 1984 and was designed to create a zany parade

that would provide entertainment through a parody, spoof, or creative expression.

Parade Date: Saturday, June 6, 2015

Check-in: The parade begins downtown at the MPI Research Parking Lot on Lovell Street and ends in the

same location. Parade units are assigned a specific parade staging location. A representative from the parade unit must check-in with the official by the time stated in the final information

packet. The lot opens at 9 a.m. for check-in.

Parade Time: Parade steps off at 11 am.

Parade Route: The route includes Lovell Street to Park Street, Park Street to Michigan Avenue, Michigan

Avenue to Portage Street, and Portage Street back to Lovell Street. Cars cannot park in the

parade staging areas.

Viewing Stand: There is no Viewing stand. You are performing full-time for the thousands of spectators,

beginning to end. Units may not stop to perform; performances must have "momentum."

Noise Restrictions: Please do not use horns or sirens unless an emergency situation exists. Sound amplifier range

must be limited to your entry.

Animal Units: You are required to have someone cleaning up behind your animal (especially horses) at all

times. A fine will be assessed for clean-up expenses. The parking lot can be hot, please make

sure that your animals are cared for with water and safety from the hot pavement.

Signage: ONLY 10% of your unit may promote your organization/business. Signage must be appropriate

and complement the parody theme.

Vehicles: Only vehicles designated on your application will be allowed in the staging area. Band

equipment vehicles will be allowed in the staging area, but not on the parade route. ALL UNITS

MUST BE DECORATED COMPLETELY and follow the theme/parody.

Floats: Trailers are not allowed in the MPI Research Parking Lot area (this is a risk management

directive). If you have a trailer, please check the float box. Trailers must be state licensedapproved and all safety and precaution measures must be implemented. Approved railings and seating is required for anyone traveling on the float. Floats cannot exceed 12 feet high from the

ground.

Distribution: For the safety of others, no items may be thrown from your parade unit, including candy,

souvenirs, and balloons. Literature is not allowed. Items for distribution must be approved.

Designated walkers must HAND the items to the spectators.

Disclaimer: The Do-Dah Parade Committee reserves the right to remove any entry from the parade before

and during the parade if the entry is not as stated in the parade application, or is otherwise

deemed unsuitable.

Final Note: Parade units that do not implement the theme (parody) as described on the application will not

be allowed entry in future Do-Dah Parades.
